Covered Workbooks & Brown
Grocery Bags Wrapping Paper,
Greeting Cards **Cardboard** –
Corrugated, Drink Holders, Boxes
Shredded Paper (in paper bags)

NO - Recyclables in Bags

NO - Hoses

NO - Batteries

NO - Dry-Cleaning Bags

NO - Used Paper Towels

NO - Medical Waste

NO - Plastic Wrapping

NO - Styrofoam

NO - Clothing

NO - Diapers

NO - Disposable Items

NO - Used Paper Plates



The items listed above should be placed in your Trash except for Batteries/Propane Tanks, which should be brought to the HHW Facility.

Reminders:

- ⇒ Recycling Bins must be left curbside for pick up
- ⇒ Mixed Paper/Cardboard must be separated from Plastic, Metal, Glass & Cartons

Hello! ARE YOU ONE OF THE BEST RECYCLERS ON YOUR STREET?

YOU MIGHT BE IF YOUR BINS CONTAIN ONLY THE ITEMS ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THIS FLYER.

But wait!

You could still be one of the WORST RECYCLERS if you ALSO:

- X Bundle items in plastic bags before you place them into your bins**
- X Place plastic bags, plastic film into your bins – or any item not on the list**
- X Place electric cords, clothes, toys, garden hoses in your bins - or any item not on the list**

IF IT'S NOT ON THE LIST, IT IS NOT RECYCLABLE!!

IF IT'S NOT RECYCLABLE, IT IS UNACCEPTABLE!!

This summer, quality control staff will be in your neighborhood to inspect curbside recycling bins to improve the quality and quantity of recyclable items.

A recent study of residential curbside-collected recyclables hauled to the Rockland Green recycling facility showed that too many loads cannot be recycled because the residents are placing non-recyclable items in their bins such as plastic bags, electrical cords, and other unacceptable items (see list on previous page).

ATTENTION!

Haulers will ONLY collect recycling bins that contain items which are on the

"What Can Be Recycled in Rockland County" list in this flyer.

Rockland Conservation Corps members and Rockland Green staff will be in various neighborhoods across Rockland County to check on our recycling progress. No worries if you are doing a great job! (You might even get an award.) You can recognize these staff members by their neon yellow vests, Rockland Green shoulder bags, and cars with the Rockland Green logo.

If your recycling bin(s) contain unacceptable items, your bin(s) will get an "OOPS!" sticker and WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.

The sticker will let you know what the unacceptable item is, so that you can avoid that mistake in the future.

This is part of a national program called "Feet on the Street", developed by The Recycling Partnership (www.Recyclingpartnership.org).
