RESOLUTION NO. 302

CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENTS OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE LEGISLATURE AND THE MINORITY LEADER TO THE ROCKLAND COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE LEGISLATURE TO EXECUTE A CERTIFICATE TO BE FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE

Mr. Lawless offered the following resolution which was seconded by Mr. Levine and unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 434 of the Laws of 1993, known as, Title 13-M of the Public Authorities Law of the State of New York, Rockland County was granted the power and authority to establish a Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2053-c (7) (a) before such authority can be created, Rockland County must, among other things, file with the Secretary of State a resolution approving the creation of the authority; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2053-c (7)(a), such resolution approving the creation of the authority, shall be filed in the office of the Secretary of State "together with a certificate approved by the County Legislature and signed by the County Executive setting forth:

- (1) the name of the authority;
- (2) the names of the initial members; and
- (3) the effective date of the title", and

WHEREAS, by this resolution the Legislature of Rockland County will approve such certificate and authorize the Chairman of the Legislature to execute same; and

WHEREAS, it is required that the certificate contains the names of the initial members; and

WHEREAS, Section 2053-c provides for the Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority to consist of fifteen (15) members; and

WHEREAS, eight (8) of the fifteen (15) members shall be members of the County Legislature; five (5) of the eight (8) members to be appointed by the Chairman of the Legislature and three (3) of the eight (8) members to be appointed Minority Leader of the County Legislature subject, in each case, to confirmation by a majority vote of the County Legislature; and
