Damiani: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. As my memo indicates, we are looking to increase the operation efficiencies for cleaning out the load-out tunnel at the West Nyack Transfer Station. Just to remind you that between all three transfer stations we load out annually over 10,000 trailers a year. Roughly 6,000 trailers load out of the West Nyack Transfer Station. This will increase efficiency as well as allow us to safely clean out the load-out tunnel.

Phillips: We were able to take it off SourceWell; so, we didn't have to go out to bid for this to saving the taxpayers money.
