AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF WHIRLWIND CREATIVE, INC. CHANGE ORDER No. 1 FOR CONTRUCTION & INSTALLATION OF IMMERSIVE THEATER & EDUCATION EXHIBITS

Phillips: Mr. Executive Director, do you want to state the cost and what we are doing here?

Damiani: Yes. Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Seeking authorization to increase Whirlwind Creative's contract amount by \$28,276.50. This will enhance Exhibit 5 with the installation of a seventy-five-inch flat screen panel with eight rail push buttons to showcase various video segments of the Materials Recovery Facility incorporating the scale in procedures, tip floor operations, side sorting, optical sorting, magnetic sorting, and baling operations. The original design was called for a simple Materials Recovery Facility mural. Additionally, we are adding a third projector within the theater which will allow for the use of a standard thumb drive which is not tied into the theater control lighting or the special effects. This will allow for separate presentations when residents, schools and businesses visit to see the Rockland experience.
