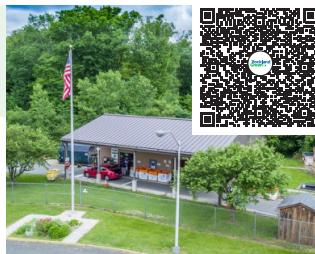

SPECIAL FACILITIES

Household Hazardous Waste Facility (HHW)
📍 35 Firemens Memorial Drive
Pomona, NY 10970

The HHW is a drop-off collection facility that accepts household hazardous waste from Rockland County residents and small businesses that qualify for CESQG status.



Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)
📍 420 Torne Valley Road
Hillburn, NY 10931

This facility processes only in-county commingled containers, mixed paper, and cardboard. This is then sorted, shipped, and made into new products.



Co-Composting Facility
📍 400 Torne Valley Road
Hillburn, NY 10931

This facility recycles bio-solids from wastewater treatment plants in Rockland County. The bio-solids are mixed with clean wood waste and then composted.



Clarkstown Concrete & Asphalt Crushing Facility
📍 166 S Route 303
West Nyack, NY 10994

This facility is for the disposal of residential or commercial construction and demolition debris from any location or source. All loads for disposal must be delivered in a truck.



RG C.A.R.E.S Animal Shelter

A fully funded, humane, no-kill animal shelter providing restorative care and adoption services for Rockland County's rescued animals at a 97% save rate.

Grass, leaves, and brush are collected throughout the county and then composted, mulched, and marketed for distribution to residents and municipalities.



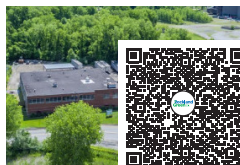
