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filled in, in ink or by typing on original bid form. No photocopies will be accepted. **No bid will be accepted which contains any changes, additions, omissions, or erasures.**

The Executive Director for the Rockland Green reserves the right to waive any informality and to reject any or all bids.

Bidder must submit with bid detailed specifications, circulars, and all necessary data on items he proposes to furnish. This information must show clearly that the item offered meets all detailed specifications herein. The Executive Director reserves the right to reject any bid if its compliance with the specifications is not clear.

Bids on equipment must be on standard new equipment, of latest model, and in current production, unless otherwise specified. All supplies, equipment, vehicles, and materials must meet the provisions of the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA).

All Vendors must comply with provisions of the Toxic Waste Right to Know Law and provide Rockland Green with all information as required by law.

The prices submitted shall be exclusive of Federal and State taxes and must not include any tax for which the bidder may claim exemption because of doing business with Rockland Green.

The right is reserved to award bids on individual items or on total sums. Awards will be made to the lowest responsible bidder, as will best promote the public interest, taking into consideration the reliability of the bidder, the quality of the materials, equipment, or supplies to be furnished, their conformity with the specifications, the purposes for which required, and the terms of delivery.

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INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

OBLIGATION OF BIDDERS

A Contractor shall not plead misunderstanding or deception because of estimates of quantities, character, location, or other conditions surrounding the same. Permission will not be given to withdraw, or modify, or explain any proposal or bid after it has been opened.

The proposal shall specify the costs, in the manner hereafter described for which the items will be supplied according to the specifications, together with a unit price for each of the separate items as called for. Any proposal shall be deemed informal which does not contain prices set opposite to each of the several items for which there is a quantity exhibited in the itemized proposal.

BID SECURITY

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check made payable to the Rockland Green in the amount indicated on the attached Affidavit of Non-Collusion. In lieu of such check, the bidder may furnish a bid bond in the same amount and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of New York and approved by Rockland Green's Attorney.

Checks or bid bonds of all formal bidders will be returned after the contract has been executed.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

Award of contract will be made to the lowest responsible qualified bidder whose proposal shall comply with all of the provisions required to render it formal. Rockland Green or the Executive Director reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all proposals and may advertise for new proposals, if the best interest of Rockland Green will be served. Rockland Green or the Executive Director may require any or all bidders to present evidence of experience, ability and financial standing as well as a statement as to the equipment which the bidder will have available for the executing of this contract. Rockland Green reserves the right to award this contract either on an item-by-item basis or as a total award of all items in combination.

EXECUTION OF CONTRACT

The bidder whose proposal is accepted will be required to execute the contract and furnish bonds and evidence of insurance within five days from date of Notice of Award, if required. In case of failure or refusal on the part of the bidder to enter into contract or to furnish bonds, if required, within the set period, the amount of deposit may be forfeited to Rockland Green and the contract may be awarded to the next lowest responsible bidder. Upon the execution of the contract and approval of the bond, the deposit will be returned to the proposer. The deposit of persons other than the one to whom award of contract is made will be returned to the person or persons making the proposal immediately after the contract and bonds have been executed. Do not submit a draft contract with your bid. Draft contracts containing terms that are not consistent with bid documents may result in rejection of the bid.

Form of proposal as issued by Rockland Green shall be filled in, in ink or typing. No bid will be accepted which contains any changes, additions, omissions, or erasures.

EXPERIENCE & EQUIPMENT

Bidder shall submit with the proposal a Certificate of Experience for the past three (3) years. Certificate of Experience is included in these documents, if applicable.

ASSIGNABILITY OF CONTRACT

The Contractor is prohibited from assigning, transferring, conveying, sub-contracting or disposing of this contract, or of any part thereof, or any payment to become due thereunder, or of his right, title or interest therein or his power to execute such contract to any other person or corporation without the previous consent in writing of the OWNER awarding the contract. If the Contractor fails to comply with this clause, the owner may immediately declare breach of contract.

USE OF PREMISES

The Contractor shall confine his equipment and the storage of materials, if any, and the portion of his employees to the limits directed by the owner and shall not encumber the premises or any part thereof with his materials or equipment. All work shall be accomplished in such a manner as not to interfere with the orderly conduct of the business of the Rockland Green. Since the buildings are occupied, personnel shall be instructed to refrain from unworkmanlike conduct while on the job.

FAILURE TO PERFORM

Should the Contractor fail to perform as required by the specifications, Rockland Green may cancel the order and terminate the contract. In such event, Rockland Green will assume no responsibility for, nor will it reimburse the Contractor for any expense or loss to the contractor because of such termination or cancellation. Rockland Green will then purchase products/service on the open market and charge back the differences to defaulting vendor.

AMENDMENTS TO BID

Any verbal information obtained from, or statements made by the Representative of the Rockland Green or his designee at the time of examination of the documents or site shall not be construed as, in any way, amending Contract documents. Only such corrections or addenda as are issued by Rockland Green in writing to all Contractors shall become a part of the Contract. Any addendum issued during the time of bidding shall be included in bids and become a part of the Contract Agreement.

INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR: The CORPORATION / CONTRACTOR/ AGENCY / CONSULTANT, is an independent contractor and covenants and agrees that it, its agents, servants and/or employees, will neither hold itself/themselves out as, nor claim to be an employee, servant or agent of Rockland Green, and that it, its agents and employees will not make claim, demand or application to or for any right or privilege applicable to an officer or employee of Rockland Green including, but not limited to, Worker's Compensation coverage, unemployment insurance benefits, Social Security Coverage or retirement membership or credit.

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INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

As a contractor or vendor providing services or hosting projects for ROCKLAND COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY DBA ROCKLAND GREEN, we require that you provide us with the following as outlined below prior to the commencement of any work.

- Executed Contract or an issuance of official purchase order.
- Certificate of Insurance with the minimum requirements outlined below.
- Hold Harmless Agreement.

GENERAL LIABILITY: The CONTRACTOR shall, at its/his/her own cost and expense, procure and maintain insurance to cover his/her/its work, services, employees, agents, and servants under the terms of this agreement which shall include, but not be limited to:

- General Aggregate (other than Prod/Comp Ops Liability) \$2,000,000
- Products/Completed Operations Aggregate \$2,000,000
- Personal & Advertising Injury Liability \$1,000,000
- Each Occurrence \$1,000,000
- Damages to Premises Rented to You (Any one fire) \$300,000
- Medical Expense (Any one person) \$5,000

- ROCKLAND COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY DBA ROCKLAND GREEN, named as Additional Insured using ISO form CG2010 and including Completed Operations using form CG2037 or copies of the equivalent.
- Additional Insured Status must be on a primary and non-contributory basis.
- The General Aggregate must apply on a per project basis.
- Broad Form Blanket Contractual Liability for liability assumed under the executed contract attached and all other Contracts relative to the project.
- Waiver of Subrogation in favor of ROCKLAND COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY DBA ROCKLAND GREEN, Form # CG2404 or equivalent.
- 30-day notice of cancellation applies per policy provisions and 10-days for non-payment of premium to ROCKLAND COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY DBA ROCKLAND GREEN in the event of cancellation or change of coverage.
- Copies of declaration pages including forms for review and approval.

WORKERS COMPENSATION and Employer's Liability: The CONTRACTOR shall procure, pay for, and maintain during the entire term of the contract such insurance as will protect both the owner and the contractor from claims under worker's compensation acts and amendments thereto and from any other claims for property damage and for personal injury including death, which may arise from

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operations under this contract, whether such operations by contractor or by any other party directly or indirectly employed by the Contractor. Copy of Certificates to be provided to the Rockland Green. Terms of this agreement which shall include, but not be limited to:

- Workers' Compensation \$1,000,000 Limits
- Employer's Liability
- Bodily Injury by Accident \$1,000,000 each accident
- Bodily Injury by Disease \$1,000,000 policy limit
- Bodily Injury by Disease \$1,000,000 each employee
- All States Endorsement

COMPREHENSIVE AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE: The CONTRACTOR shall procure, pay for, and maintain during the entire term of the contract. Terms of this agreement which shall include, but not be limited to:

- Commercial Auto Liability Insurance covering the use of all Owned, Non Owned, and Hired Vehicles with combined Bodily Injury and Property Damage Limit of at least \$1,000,000.
- No fault liability as required by statute.

DISABILITY INSURANCE & UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE: The Contractor shall procure, pay for, and maintain during the entire term of the contract any disability benefits and unemployment insurance as required by law. Copies of Certificates are to be provided to the Rockland Green.

Umbrella Liability: The CONTRACTOR shall, at its/his/her own cost and expense, procure and maintain insurance to cover his/her/its work, services, employees, agents, and servants under the terms of this agreement which shall include, but not be limited to:

- Each Occurrence and Aggregate \$5,000,000
- The Umbrella must be excess over the General Liability, Automobile and Employers Liability.
- Copies of declaration pages including forms for review and approval.

Pollution Liability: The CONTRACTOR shall, at its/his/her own cost and expense, procure and maintain insurance to cover his/her/its work, services, employees, agents, and servants under the terms of this agreement which shall include, but not be limited to:

- Each Occurrence and Aggregate \$1,000,000

The above coverages must be placed with an insurance company with an A.M. Best rating of A-:VII or better.

CONTRACTOR TO HAVE ALL OTHER INSURANCE REQUIRED BY LAW.

When the CONTRACTOR signs and returns this agreement, the contractor shall provide Rockland Green with a policy endorsement showing the above required insurance. **The Rockland Green shall be named as additional insured on all insurance policies and policy endorsements, and the policies and policy endorsements shall provide that the insurance shall not be canceled or terminated without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Rockland Green.** Unless and until CONTRACTOR obtains such insurance and provides a policy endorsement to Rockland Green, this agreement shall not be effective, and no moneys shall be paid or given to the CONTRACTOR.

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COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

The Contractor shall comply with all the provisions of laws in the State of New York and of the United States of America which affect public authorities and public authority contracts, and more particularly the Labor Law, the Immigration and Naturalization Laws and Regulation, the General Municipal Law, the Workers' Compensation Law, the Lien Law, Personal Property Law, State Unemployment Insurance Law, Federal Social Security Law, State, Local and Municipal Health Laws, Rules and Regulation, and any and all regulations promulgated by the State of New York and of amendments and additions thereto, insofar as the same shall be applicable to any contract awarded hereunder with the same force and effect as if set forth at length herein. The bidder's special attention is called to those laws which are set forth in detail below:

A. NON-COLLUSIVE BIDDING CERTIFICATION

The attention of the bidder is called to Rockland Green's Procurement Policy, which reads as follows:

- (1) Every bid or proposal hereafter made to Rockland Green, for work, goods, equipment, or services shall contain the following statement subscribed by the bidder or proposer and affirmed by such bidder as true under the penalties of perjury:

"(a) By submission of this [bid or proposal] each [bidder or proposer] and each person signing on behalf of any [bidder or proposer] certifies, and in the case of a joint [bid or proposal] each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of his knowledge and belief:

- (1) The prices in this [bid or proposal] have been arrived at independently without collusion, consultation, communication, or agreement for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other [bidder or proposer] or with any competitor.
