

# Presentation FAQ

## **Who can book a Solid Waste Management Authority presentation?**

- Rockland County private and public Elementary, Middle and Senior High schools, Rockland County Colleges
- Adult groups (such as civic, senior, garden, residential and other interested groups)
- Presentations are available to schools and organizations outside of Rockland County with approval by the Education Coordinator (Call for more information)

## **What are the requirements to book a presentation?**

- An appointment must be prearranged with the Assistant Educator
- Minimum group size 10 people

## **When are the presentations given?**

- Monday through Friday - for a Saturday or Sunday contact the Assistant Educator
- Morning, afternoon, and evening presentations are available

## **How long are the presentations?**

- The presentation can be between 1 - 2 hours and is customized for each group

## **Who will be conducting the tour?**

- The Assistant Educator conducts the entire presentation

## **What will we be discussed during the presentation?**

- The presentation begins with an introduction to the Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority
- How our waste in Rockland County is managed - mixed paper and container recycling, hazardous waste, trash and composting
- Through an interactive discussion the students, residents, organizations or businesses will have a good understanding of solid waste management programs, environmental concerns and solutions.
- A short video showing how paper, glass, metal and plastic recyclables are separated before they are sent to remanufacturing facilities to be made into new products
